Auxiliary veterinary nurse

Principle Role

The Auxiliary Veterinary Nurse works under the supervision of the Head Nurse and Senior Nurse and is a key member of their nursing group within the overall nursing team and as such will be actively involved in the day-to-day activities of their group to ensure efficient, professional, and caring services to clients according to the practice policy. The Auxiliary nurse will provide support and assistance to the clinical staff and consistently maintain a high standard of hygiene through the surgery building.

Key Roles

1. To actively participate in a supporting capacity with nursing duties wherever possible, assisting the clinical staff by carrying out all reasonable instructions.
2. To work efficiently to maintain the professional and personal standards required by the practice. To promote the image of the practice by being personally approachable.
3. To be flexible in working practices and amenable to day-to-day rota amendments requested by the Head Nurse to ensure all surgeries are staffed to the required level.
4. To consistently maintain high levels of cleanliness and hygiene through the practice buildings. To maintain the instrumentation and equipment used during the working day.
5. To work consistently within the constraints of the practice Health and Safety Policy.
6. By contributing towards the maintenance of an effective communication system, to communicate effectively at all levels (including with the Director's and the Head Nurse), thus ensuring the rapid transfer of information.
